

High School Preparation (HSP)

The **High School Preparation** course at CCEL provides students with the opportunity to improve their language skills in a fun and supportive environment.

They will develop confidence in using English for all aspects of their daily life and build confidence in using English while at school. Students will gain skills they will be able to use anywhere, while making friends from around the world.

About HPS

HSP is designed to help students prepare for high school study in New Zealand. Depending on the time of year students may be in closed classes with only other high school students or integrated into CCEL's General English classes. Both options will give students the opportunity to develop their English skills while having fun.

Entry Requirements

- Minimum age 15 years old
- Pre-Intermediate to Advanced level of English closed classes
- Elementary to Advanced level of English integrated classes

Sample Learner Outcomes

In integrated classes students will:

- Develop their language skills
- Build confidence in communication skills
- Participate in project work
- Develop their vocabulary
- Participate in extensive reading programmes
- Have one-to-one tutorials with their teachers (depends on length of enrolment – minimum of 5 weeks required)
- Have their progress monitored
- Start dates, any Monday (unless Monday is a public holiday)

In addition to the above students in closed classes will:

- Learning key language for a range subject areas for example Mathematics, Science, History and Literature
- Develop independent and cooperative research skills to complete projects
- Enjoy a range of activities both in school based and, in the community

Assessment

- Listening, reading, writing and speaking skills are assessed through five weekly level tests
- Participating in class tasks, individual and group, and completing set tasks assigned
